INTRODUCTION



Donghua University (DHU), located in Shanghai, was founded in 1951 and became a state-key university in 1960. DHU is one of the 75 universities that are under the direct management of the Ministry of Education of China. From 1954, DHU commenced to accept international students, these were among the first groups of overseas students enrolled by Chinese universities. The International Cultural Exchange School (ICES) is committed to fostering the internationalization of DHU, recruiting and cultivating international talents, and promoting intercultural understanding. The Chinese Language Center (CLC) of ICES offers a variety of non-degree Chinese programs to meet different learning needs and schedules.

ACADEMICS

The **Chinese Language Center (CLC)** has an excellent academic team with rich experience in teaching Chinese as a second language. 20% of teachers have more than 10 years of teaching experience and 35% have 5-10 years of teaching experience. Student evaluations of teachers and teaching quality consistently exceeds above 4.6 points out of 5 each semester.

The CLC emphasizes teacher training to assure a high standard of teaching quality for all classes, in addition to a rigorous teacher selection process. A Continuous Professional Development (CPD) project has also been implemented, which includes class observations, performance reviews, group class preparations, in-class teacher training, etc. All these measures aim to bring about an efficient pedagogy and improve the overall study experience for students at different levels of Chinese proficiency.



Textbooks focus on daily application


The CLC uses the series of textbooks "Chinese in Real Life" published by Shanghai Jiao Tong University Press. These textbooks are compiled by the CLC with content that is consistent with contemporary daily life in China.

Online learning materials make study easy

The CLC provides students with various online Chinese learning materials including keywords, language points, recorded videos, dialogue videos, audio, course summaries, etc. Through different online platforms such as ClassIn, Voicethread, Quizlet, Canvas, etc., students in both online and offline courses are able to review their courses at any time convenient to them.

Assistants are ready to support

Each class, no matter if it is online or offline, will have at least one Chinese student working as an assistant to provide additional support to students after class. All assistants receive training before they take on their responsibilities and also during the program.



ONLINE LEARNING MATERIALS



Accommodation

Accommodation is available for students studying in full-time in-person General Chinese Programs and Vacation Chinese Programs. The International Student Apartments (ISAs) are located on the Yan'an Road Campus. Accommodation fees must be paid in one lump sum for a whole semester before check-in. You can reserve accommodations by logging into your online application account after being admitted by DHU.

Facilities

Each room is equipped with a private bathroom, bedding, furniture, air-conditioner, TV set, fridge and Internet jack. In the public areas in the building, there are washing machines, hot & cold water dispensers, microwave ovens, electronic stoves, as well as a public room, professional laundry service, a self-study lounge and an activity room.

Hot water & electricity

A student may need to pay utility fees like hot water and electricity fees online.

Internet

The accommodation fee excludes the Internet fee. China Telecom, China Mobile, China Unicom are available to choose from.

Visa

Admitted students should apply to their local China Embassy or Consulate for an X1 or X2 visa with the admission documents offered by ICES, and then enter mainland China with a valid visa within the specified time. Insurance

According to the government requirement, all international students should purchase the designated insurance covering the study period in China, It is Comprehensive Medical Insurance & Protection Scheme for Foreigners Staying in China offered by Guoren Property & Casualty Insurance Co., Ltd. APPLICATION

Program Schedule

The schedule and application deadline of each program will be announced approximately 5 months in advance. Please visit our website for the final schedule and complete your application before the deadline.

Eligibility

- Non-Chinese citizen in good health.
- Aged between 16 and 60, and have a valid ordinary foreign passport. The passport should have at least 6-month validity.
- The applicant living in China should have a valid Chinese visa.

Application Deadline

Spring Semester	Early January
Fall Semester	Around July 15
Summer	Around May 15
Winter	Varies (dependant on Chinese New Year dates)

* The above deadline is tentative and only for in-person programs.

* The deadline for online programs may be extended.

1 Apply online

Sign up an account with your passport number at <https://admissions.dhu.edu.cn>, fill in your personal information and choose the language program you want to apply. Upload the required documents, including a scanned passport information page and bareheaded electronic ID photo.

**Please remember your login information, which will be used frequently in the future.*

2 Pay the application fee online

After receiving a confirmation email, log into your account at <https://admissions.dhu.edu.cn/> and pay online (Visa, MasterCard, WeChat, or Alipay). You can also choose to pay at the ICES office with cash in CNY or with a China UnionPay card.

3 Wait for the admissions result

The admission process may take 2-4 weeks or even longer depends on the volume of the applications. The result will be sent through email. If the student who applies for a General Chinese Program or Vacation Program needs a student visa, the hard copy of "Admission Notice" and the JW202 Form (Visa Application for Study in China) will be provided.

4 Take online placement test (new students only)

An admitted new student needs to take the online Chinese placement test (written test only) within the specified period. The student will be assigned to a corresponding class based on the test result. Current students will be assigned to classes directly according to their language level the previous term. In the 1st week, students are allowed to change the course level within a specific timeframe.

Scholarships

A student can apply to study in General Chinese Program at Donghua University for one semester or one year as a general scholar under the sponsorship of Chinese Government Scholarships (CSC) or International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship (ICLTS).
