- Our campus locates in the heart of the city of Shanghai, one of the most attractive cities in China.
- Each semester, more than 1000 international students from nearly 100 countries choose to enhance their Chinese proficiencies with us.



Donghua University (DHU) is located in Shanghai. It was founded in 1951 and approved as the state-key university in 1960. DHU is one of the 75 universities that are under the direct management of the Ministry of Education of China. As early as 1954, Donghua University commenced to accept the international students who were among the first group of overseas students enrolled by Chinese universities. Nearly 5000 international students study at Donghua University each year. International Cultural Exchange School (ICES) offers diverse non-degree Chinese programs to meet various time schedules and learning demands.

General Chinese Programs:

A (18 weeks, on the mornings, from Mon. to Fri.)

B (one month after A, 14 weeks, on the mornings, from Mon. to Fri.)

Practical Chinese Programs:

C (15 weeks, on the mornings of Mon. Wed. & Fri.)

D (15 weeks, Tues. & Thurs., only for exchange students)

E (15 weeks, on the evenings of Mon. Wed. & Thurs.)

F (15 weeks, on the mornings and afternoons of Sat.)

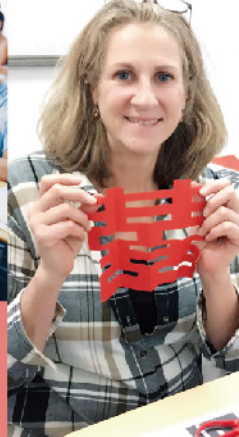
Colorful extra-curricular activities and experience Chinese culture

- **Phase One:** Both Visa Application Form and Admission Notice can be offered to those who finish application before the Phase One date.
- **Phase Two:** Only Admission Notice can be offered to those who finish application before the Phase Two date.
- **Class size:** The minimum size of each class is 8 students and the average is about 20.
- Legal holidays will be followed during the semester.
- Sit in on a class is not permitted.

Eligibility

- Between 16 and 60 years' old, and have a valid ordinary foreign passport.
- Non-Chinese citizen in good health.
- Applicant in China should have a valid visa.

(Designated textbooks are for free)

- Tuition of one semester must be paid in one lump sum.
- No matter one attends the class or not, tuition will be refunded only 50% if one quits school within the first week; no tuition will be refunded from the second week on.

Scholarships

Students can apply for **Chinese Government Scholarships (CSC)** or **International Chinese Language Teachers (Confucius Institute) Scholarship** to study Program A as a general scholar, for one semester or one year.

Student who is studying overseas at the Confucius Institute has the qualification to apply for this Scholarship.

On-campus accommodation (ISAs)

International Student Apartment (ISAs) locates on Yan'an road campus with 3 types of rooms. Accommodation fees must be paid by one semester (about 130 days) in one lump sum at check-in. After being admitted, please log in your personal accounts at admissions.dhu.edu.cn, click "School Dorm" to make the reservation.

- **Facilities:** Each room is equipped with bathroom, bedding, furniture, air-conditioner, fridge, TV set, internet jact, etc. In the public areas, there are washing machines, hot & cold water dispensers, microwave ovens, electromagnetic stoves, as well as common rooms, professional laundry service, self-study lounge, etc.
- **Water, Electricity & Internet:** Extra fees are required.

* Renting an apartment outside the campus is permitted. It is estimated about CNY 3000 to CNY 5000 each month. ICES offers shuttle bus service to those who live in the foreigner gathering areas such as Hongquan Rd., Fengdu International, Mingdu City, Jinxiu Jiangnan and Gubei. Fee of shuttle bus service is CNY 400-500/semester.

Visa application

The admitted student is required apply for a Student Visa (X1 or X2) at China Embassy or Consulate with the admission documents offered by ICES, then enter China mainland and come to ICES for enrollment with that Student Visa. The student will be rejected to enroll or study at Donghua University if he/she does not have valid X1, X2 or Residence Permit on the passport.

Airport pick-up service & ISAs check-in

ICES offers pick-up service for the newcomers arriving at either Terminal 1 or Terminal 2 of Pudong International Airport (PVG). Volunteers will wait near the exit of International Arrival of two Terminals and send you to the coach that will leave for campus at 10:00, 15:00 and 19:00. This service will be offered only on the designated days below. If missed, please come to the campus by yourself. The first pick-up day is as well the day from which one can check in to ISAs (on-campus dorm).

Tuition payment & Insurance

You are suggested to pay the tuition in the following ways in advance to avoid the long queue on the enrollment day:

- **Pay online (recommended):** Use your Visa card, MasterCard, UnionPay card or Wechat Pay, Alipay with the online payment service. Log in your personal account at admissions.dhu.edu.cn, click "academic information → application progress → payment information → online payment" and pay.
- **Pay at ICES office:** with RMB cash or UnionPay card.

* Each student is expected to buy an insurance of which the validity should be enough to cover one's study duration. Those who study for one semester can buy it in their home countries or at ICES; those who study for two semesters or more are required to buy it at ICES. The "Comprehensive Medical Insurance & Protection Scheme for Foreigners Staying in China" offered by Ping An Annuity Insurance Co., Ltd. costs CNY 400/semester and needs to be paid at enrollment.

How to apply

1 Online Application

Prepare in advance the JPG format of the electronic ID photo (similar size as the photo on the passport) and the scanned passport information page, then register a personal account at admissions.dhu.edu.cn. Complete the "Personal Information" and the upload of photo & passport page, as well as the "Academic Information" by choosing the program you plan to learn. After an initial review by the university, applicants will receive a confirming email with the relevant guides.

2 Application Fee Payment

- Pay online (recommended): log in your personal account at admissions.dhu.edu.cn, click "academic info → application progress → payment information → online payment". Visa card, MasterCard, Union Pay card or Wechat Pay, Alipay with online payment service are applicable.
- Pay at ICES office: with RMB cash or UnionPay card.

3 Admission

- Your application will be officially reviewed then. If you are admitted, the university will prepare your admission documents — Admission Notice and/or JW202 Form (Visa Application for Study in China), which takes around 20 working days or more. Meanwhile, you can log in your personal account again at admissions.dhu.edu.cn to make the dorm reservation, if you plan to reside on campus.
- The admitted students can choose the way to receive the admission documents: come to the university to collect them, or ask for the express. Contact information such as telephone number, contact person, and the address must be correctly and accurately provided to the university. Otherwise, the admitted students will take the consequences accordingly.

Enrollment

- In order to avoid the long queue on the enrollment day, the admitted students are encouraged to finish tuition payment and online Chinese placement test within designated period before the new semester starts. To complete this, one should log in their personal account at admissions.dhu.edu.cn.
- **Enrollment:** Each admitted student, including those who have completed the tuition payment and online Chinese placement test, is required come to the university on the day designated on the Admission Notice for the enrollment & orientation. Important affairs such as instructions on visa renewal & extension, collection of one's student ID card & textbooks, payment of tuition or insurance, and/or Chinese placement test must be processed on this day. Meanwhile, one can purchase the shuttle bus card or food card (used at the university canteens).
- **Late enrollment:** late enrollment will not be accepted. In addition, for those who have already received the student visas or Residence Permits based on the documents provided by the university, their student visas or Residence Permits will be cancelled by the Exit-Entry Administration Bureau soon after the enrollment day.
