Flexible Schooling

There are both spring and autumn intake each year. Students who have HSK 4 above 180 scores are eligible to apply. Student who has higher Chinese proficiency is possible to start from a higher level and graduate in less than 4 years (at least 2 years) if meets the relevant requirements.

Scholarships

Applicant may apply for Chinese Government Scholarship (Type-A) as entrance scholarship. In addition, based on one's attendance, academic performance, enrolled student also has opportunities to be awarded various kinds of scholarships sponsored by DHU, Chinese government, or enterprises.

Study abroad

DHU has student exchange agreements with overseas universities, which offers excellent students opportunities to study in the third country. While enriching one's international experiences and broadening one's views, a certain credits acquired at host institutions will be recognized and transferred to DHU credits.

Knowledge of Business and Trade

Students will not only learn Chinese language and culture, but also will have access to basic theories and practices of business and trade. It is also possible to choose business related elective courses provided by the School of Business & Management in junior and senior year.

Internship

Internship is an important part of the curriculum. Students will earn practical skills, such as consultation, interpretation, meeting preparation, data collection and cultural exchange, while work as an intern and get ready for future career. The international Student Center for Career Development (ISuCCeeD) will provide career service for students.

Career prospects

With the excellent Chinese language skills and deep understanding of China's economic society, graduates are able to take an active part in various fields, such as interpretation, translation, business and administration in foreign companies, joint ventures and Chinese companies.

Compulsory Courses

Comprehensive Chinese, Chinese Listening & Speaking, Audio-Visual-Oral Chinese, Introduction to China, Business Chinese, Literature Reading, International Trade, Contemporary Topics, Business research, etc.

Elective courses

Physical Education, Psychology of Happiness, Chinese Folklore, Career Guidance, Shanghai Dialect, Comparison of Sino-Western Cultures, Translation Practice, Chinese Business Culture, Introduction to Business, etc.

★ Up-grading

The students who have obtained all the required credits and passed the required HSK level can advance to the next grade: one must acquire HSK level 4 (above 210 scores) from Semester 2 to Semester 3; one must acquire HSK level 6 (above 180 scores) from Semester 4 to Semester 5. Those who fail the make-up tests of two or more compulsory courses in one semester are not allowed to advance to the next grade.

★ Graduation

Students who have obtained 157 credits, completed the internship and passed the thesis defense will be qualified to graduate and receive Bachelor Degree of Arts.

** The distribution of 157 credits is: 124 for compulsory courses, 20 for elective courses, 2 for Practicum, 11 for essay, thesis and internship.*
